

24. Drawing Sets of Blocks (1-9)

- NUMBER RECOGNITION (1-9)
- MAKE SETS OF SPECIFIC NUMBERS OF BLOCKS
- REPRESENT SETS THROUGH DRAWING OBJECTS

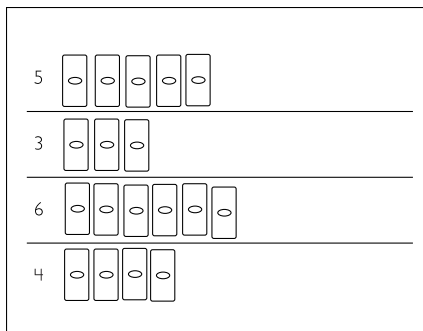
STUDENT NEEDS:

9 single blocks
worksheets
optional: rubber stamp and
ink pad

 25 minutes

INDEPENDENT WORK:

1. Students identify a number on their worksheet.
2. Students count out that number of blocks and place them in a line to the right of the number.
3. Students draw (or use Digi-Block rubber stamps) to show that number of blocks.
4. Repeat for each number.



Assessment:

DOES THE STUDENT:

- identify the written numbers correctly
- count out correct corresponding sets of blocks
- draw sets of blocks accurately

Differentiation:

REINFORCEMENT:

- Eliminate the drawing step; focus on assessing students' ability to make accurate sets of blocks for each given number.

EXTENSION:

- Have students complete the worksheet without using blocks.
