WAR! 4-B2

Objective 4-B: Compare and order amounts of money up to \$100.

**Sub-Objective:** Compare two amounts of money up to \$100.

**Type of Lesson:** Reinforcement

**Instructional Method:** Game (2-4 players)

**<u>Description</u>**: Students play War to compare amounts of money up to \$100.

**Materials:** Activity Sheet 8 (4 pages)

## **Procedure**

Set-up: Shuffle the cards (there are 48). One player deals the full deck. Depending on the number of players, each player receives 24, 16, or 12 cards.

- 1. Tell players to stack their cards face down on the table in front of them.
- 2. One at a time, players play the top card from their stack by placing it number-up in the center of the table and stating the amount. The player whose card indicates the largest amount of money wins the cards that were played. If two or more cards indicate the same amount of money, those players have a "war" to see who takes the cards. War involves putting three cards face down and the fourth card face up. The player with the highest face-up card wins all the cards that were played in the war.
- 3. Play continues round by round until one player has won all the cards from the other players. That player is the winner.

**Evidence of Learning:** The student consistently determines the larger of two amounts of money.
